Please drive carefully and park ONLY in the marked area to avoid parking fine.



Competition venue

Address: Lundgårdsvägen 15, Åre.

Arena: The race arena is the same arena as used during FIS Alpine World Cups and World Championships 2019.

Race Office: At the arena you can find the race office during the competitions.

Waxing Room: Waxing rooms will be located approximately 150 meters from the finish area. The teams have the possibility to have a space for waxing during the period of 24 January to 30 January. Keys for the waxing house will be handed out at the competition office upon arrival.

Prize giving ceremony: The award ceremony will be held 30 minutes after race at the finish area. Top three athletes will be awarded, please make sure that they are ready nearby.



Covid-19 Safety Protocol

The Swedish Parasport Federation, Swedish Paralympic Committee and the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) is glad about being able to host WPAS 2022 in Åre, Sweden. To make this possible, the LOC, in agreement with local government, health authorities and Parasport Sweden, have decided to design and implement a Safety Protocol to minimize all possible risks to an acceptable level. The main goal of this Protocol and its rules/procedures is to create a safe environment for everyone involved in the World Cup, regardless of being the athlete, official, LOC, volunteer, etc. However, this protocol does not provide a guarantee, it is only a monitoring and helps us to react as soon as possible.

The most important and effective measures for personal protection as well as for the protection of others are:

- Social/physical distancing (stay away at least 1,5 meter from each other)
- Proper hand hygiene
- Wearing a face mask covering the mouth and the nose
- Correct cough etiquette
- No sharing (food, towels, water bottle, etc.)
